## Bloom

Bi-color orange to apricot blooms spring to fall with cool night temperatures

## Benefits

Reblooming Perennial, Deer Resistance, Attracts Pollinators

## Growth Rate

Fast spring to fall

## Water

Regularly until established, then occasionally as needed

## Soil

Tolerant of most well-drained soils

## Fertilizer

Apply a balanced slow-release each spring and summer

## Pruning

Cut old flowers stems and fertilize for more blooms
