## TECOMA

*Tecoma 'TEC60109106' PP24169*

Until recently, tecomas grew huge, bloomed only in late spring and fall, and were covered in unattractive seed pods. Lydia stays more compact and blooms bright yellow flowers from early spring until frost — with less seed pods.
