## **DWARF SPIRAEA**

A great dwarf Spiraea, Little Bonnie's foliage does not "burn out" like other Spiraeas. Profuse lavender-pink spring blooms can rebloom in summer, attracting pollinators. Foliage turns bright crimson in the fall, before winter dormancy.

Moderate to Fast

#### Water

Medium water

## Soil

Well-drained garden soil with rich organic matter

## **Fertilizer**

Fertilize yearly in early spring

# **Pruning**

Deadhead after bloom, prune fall to winter
